DEMOCRACY AND ELECTIONS IN PENNSYLVANIA

The United States is a representative democracy. That means in Pennsylvania our national, state and local government is elected by our citizens. These officials represent the citizens' ideas and concerns in government. **Voting is a very important right given to US citizens**. The President is elected every 4 years. There are federal and state representatives, including Governor, and local elections every year for terms of 2 - 6 years.

During the Primary Election in Spring each year, voters will choose which candidate will move on to the 'general' election in November.

Please check the election schedule at **VOTE.PA.GOV** each year.

YOU CAN REGISTER TO VOTE IN PENNSYLVANIA IF YOU ARE:

 A UNITED STATES CITIZEN AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE the next election.

<u>AND</u>

 A RESIDENT OF PENNSYLVANIA AND YOUR ELECTION DISTRICT for AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE the next election

<u>AND</u>

 AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE ON THE DAY OF THE NEXT ELECTION.

PLAN EFFECTIVELY. GO TO VOTE.PA.GOV WHERE YOU CAN:

- CHECK your voter REGISTRATION STATUS
- CHECK the address of YOUR POLLING PLACE
- FAMILIARIZE yourself WITH THE VOTING SYSTEM at your polling place BY VIEWING THE VOTING SYSTEM DEMONSTRATION
- FILE A NEW VOTER REGISTRATION form each time you CHANGE YOUR NAME, ADDRESS, OR PARTY
- GET AN APPLICATION FOR A MAIL-IN OR ABSENTEE BALLOT which must be RECEIVED BY COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE BY 5 P.M. THE TUESDAY BEFORE THE ELECTION

STAY INVOLVED

- VOTE EVERY YEAR in the May and November elections, if eligible. <u>ALL ELECTIONS ARE IMPORTANT!</u>
- YOUR VOICE CAN BE HEARD WHEN YOU VOTE!

DECIDE HOW YOU WILL VOTE

Choose where to vote:

- In person at your polling place
- At home with a "Mail In" ballot. Request the ballot prior to election day
- At home with an "Absentee" ballot. Request the ballot prior to election day
- Find your polling place (precinct) at Vote.pa.gov

STAY INVOLVED AND INVOLVE OTHERS

ENCOURAGE FRIENDS AND FAMILY, if they are eligible, to register to vote. Remind them in person and on social media when elections take place. **REMIND THEM THAT THEIR VOICE IS IMPORTANT.** Help them get to the polls.
