- GENERAL ELECTION: NOVEMBER 5, 2024

# YOU CAN REGISTER TO VOTE IN PENNSYLVANIA IF YOU ARE:

 A UNITED STATES CITIZEN AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE the next election

#### AND

 A RESIDENT OF PENNSYLVANIA AND YOUR ELECTION DISTRICT for AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE the next election

### AND

 AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE ON THE DAY OF THE NEXT ELECTION

# PLAN EFFECTIVELY. GO TO VOTE.PA.GOV WHERE YOU CAN:

- CHECK your voter REGISTRATION STATUS
- CHECK the address of YOUR POLLING PLACE
- FAMILIARIZE yourself WITH THE VOTING SYSTEM at your polling place BY VIEWING THE VOTING SYSTEM DEMONSTRATION
- FILE A NEW VOTER REGISTRATION form each time you CHANGE YOUR NAME, ADDRESS, OR PARTY
- GET AN APPLICATION FOR A MAIL-IN OR ABSENTEE BALLOT which must be RECEIVED BY COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE BY 5 P.M. THE TUESDAY BEFORE THE ELECTION

## STAY INVOLVED

- VOTE EVERY YEAR in every election including primaries if eligible. <u>ALL ELECTIONS ARE IMPORTANT!</u>
- REMEMBER-YOUR VOICE, YOUR CHOICE!

## **GOING AWAY FOR COLLEGE?**

If you move away from home to attend college, YOU CAN VOTE BY ABSENTEE BALLOT OR by GOING HOME ON ELECTION DAY to vote at your polling place.

Alternately, you can **CHANGE YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION** to your college address and vote there.

## STAY MOTIVATED AND MOTIVATE OTHERS

**ENCOURAGE FRIENDS AND FAMILY** to register to vote and show them how. Remind them in person and on social media when elections take place. **REMIND THEM THAT THEIR VOICE IS IMPORTANT.** Help them get to the polls.
