Guide to Voting project

We have now completed the translation of our Guide to Voting in six languages--Arabic, Nepali, Somali, Spanish, Urdu, and Vietnamese. They will be distributed to the following YMCAs in Camp Hill, East Shore, Camp Curtin, Friendship and Northern Dauphin County. These distribution sites will enable us to reach a larger demographic base such as teenagers who may be eligible to register to vote, young parents, and persons with English as a second language.
